Government Agencies Register Ordinance

issued on 25 October 2007.

The government prescribes the following:

1§ Statistics Sweden shall maintain a register of government agencies.

The register shall contain information in part about courts of law, in part about government enterprises and other administrative agencies. Information about agencies as referred to in 1§ first paragraph of ordinance (1992:247) with instructions for representation abroad shall be included in the register. The register shall not contain information about committees and special analysts that are regulated in the committee ordinance (1998:1474).

2§ The register shall contain the following information about the agencies:

- corporate registration number
- name
- visiting and postal addresses
- telephone number
- fax number
- address
- website address.

3§ Information in the register shall, to the extent possible, be collected from the Business Register, as regulated by the ordinance (1984:692) on the Business Register.

4§ Statistics Sweden shall maintain the government agency register available for the public free of charge through a public website.

5§ Statistics Sweden shall assign the corporate registration numbers of government agencies in accordance with 3 § the law on identifying characteristics for legal persons etc. A corporate registration number will not be assigned if it already has a corporate registration number that the agency uses or that can be used or if it is otherwise obvious that such is not necessary.

6§ An agency under the government, as specified in 1 §, shall report the start of its operations to Statistics Sweden if the corporate registration number has not been assigned to it.

SFS 2007:755 When an agency registered under the government ceases to exist, the agency shall report this information to Statistics Sweden and report the time for the cessation.
